

# Cookies Policy

A cookie is a text file that is placed in your computer by websites that you visit. Cookies enable a website, amongst other things, to store and recover information about the navigation habits of a user or their computers, and depending on the type of information or the way in which they use their computers, cookies can be used to recognise the user.

Cookies are essential for the good functioning of the Internet. They contribute with countless advantages when providing interactive services that make the use and navigation of the web much easier.

The following information will help you understand the different types of cookies:

TYPES OF COOKIES		
ACCORDING TO THE ADMINISTRATING COMPANY	Private Cookies	Are those compiled by the publisher in order to provide the service requested by the user
	Third-Party Cookies	Are those compiled and administered by a third party and therefore, cannot be considered private cookies.

ACCORDING TO THE LENGTH OF TIME THEY REMAIN ACTIVE	Session-State Cookies	They compile data whilst the user is navigating the web with the purpose of providing the requested service.
	Persistent Cookies	They are stored in the terminal and the information obtained will be used by the cookie administrator with the purpose of providing the requested service.
ACCORDING TO THEIR PURPOSE	Process Cookies	They are necessary for correct web navigation
	Personalisation Cookies	They provide the user with the necessary (language) features and characteristics to navigate the website
	Analytics Cookies	They allow the lender to analyse the navigating habits of the users with the purpose of monitoring the use they make of the website, as well as elaborating statistic studies of the most viewed contents, number of visitors, etc.
	Advertising Cookies	They enable the publisher to include advertising sections on the website that are suitable to the website's contents.
	Behavioural Advertising Cookies	They enable the publisher to include advertising sections on the website according to information that has been obtained in relation to the user's navigating habits.

Pursuant to the provisions in the article 22.2 of the Act 34/2002, of 11th July on Services from the Society of Information and Electronic Trade (LSSI-CE), CAIMARI COMMUNICATIONS SL informs about the cookies used in our website:

PRIVATE COOKIES, TECHNICAL COOKIES AND SESSION COOKIES that enable the user to navigate the CAIMARI COMMUNICATIONS SL website, thus ensuring the correct functioning and use of the different options or services provided by the website.

THIRD PARTY COOKIES, ANALYSIS COOKIES AND SESSION COOKIES that allow CAIMARI COMMUNICATIONS SL to analyse the data from the user's navigation with the purpose of monitoring the use they make of the website, as well as elaborating statistic studies of the most viewed contents, number of visitors, etc.
